

Assessment of the cumulative impacts of the scheme as a whole found:

- Beneficial changes to air quality and noise levels within the wider study area, in particular the urban areas of Aberdeen
- Potential adverse effects on land use, the water environment, landscape and access
- Likely adverse visual impacts from outdoor public areas, but beneficial impacts for users of the proposed scheme
- Successful mitigation will be required to reduce the risk of adverse impacts on ecology due to habitat loss, fragmentation and severance
- Significant effect on farming interests
- Adverse changes to the form and composition of some watercourses
