## Forth Replacement Crossing - Fife ITS Contract

<u>Update on Intention to Progress Site Works – M90 Re-Surfacing</u>

Further to previous communications, I can confirm that the works are currently progressing steadily at various locations on the road network corridor associated with the Fife ITS Contract.

I though it appropriate to write and provide an update on our intentions particularly with regards to construction activities associated with the current resurfacing works on the M90. The extents of these works are generally between Jctn. 2A and Admiralty Jctn. 1 as indicated on the attached Site Layout sketch FRC-FITS-GC-SK-049 Rev C.

Typical work activities generally include planing out of the existing road to various depths and relaying with new road surfacing material. In addition, under this programme of works the existing southbound hard-shoulder will be upgraded for provision of a new bus lane. Site operations will involve use of heavy mechanical plant and are advancing from the north to south. The southbound carriageway works are currently approaching Masterton Jctn. 2 and will continue towards Admiralty Jctn. 1 in the coming weeks. A shorter section will then be undertaken on the northbound carriageway at Masterton Jct. 2. The re-surfacing works are scheduled for completion mid-May 2012.

These works have been carefully programmed in partnership with key stakeholders including Transport Scotland, Fife Council, Forth Estuary Transport Authority (FETA) and the Police, to minimise traffic disruption and impact on surrounding areas. In this regard, the works will be undertaken during normal daylight working hours with scheduled night-time working as necessary.

As Community Liaison Officer for the Fife ITS works, and Stakeholder Manager for Graham, I appreciate that certain activities normally associated with construction can result in both perceived and actual increased levels of nuisance and potential impacts to the surrounding environment. Typically, these activities may include machine operations, temporary lighting, construction vehicle movements etc. As intimated previously, we shall continue to monitor our activities and potential
