(iii)	PCNV 008 Mod 16 – ESQ09 and ESQ10 bridge repair works.	
	Following the discussion at the previous NLG, FCBC gave a presentation on the updated programme and sequence for these works.	
	The works are proposed to be undertaken in 4 phases between April and December 2015. Some works will take place during evening/night periods due to traffic requirements and Network Rail restrictions. The Standingstane Road bridge works are proposed to be generally carried out during the daytime and the rail bridge will be a mixture of daytime and evening/night time dependent on the area being repaired. It is envisaged that one or possibly two spans will be carried out during the daytime with the spans over the rail tracks being carried out at night. Due to of the proximity of the houses in the area FCBC are considering a number of options with regard to noise mitigation which were discussed. The NLG note that the planning for the works had allowed the durations of activities which could potentially be noisier to be reduced.

(v)	PCNV 0026 Mod 27 –South Works Areas – B800	
	FCBC explained the work required to raise the road level adjacent to the Scotstoun House junction. These works are proposed to be carried out over a weekend in May during day and night shifts as there will be lane closures required on the B800. The noisiest operations will be undertaken during the day shifts. Traffic lights will be in operation to allow the B800 to be kept open to traffic. The NLG noted the proximity of adjacent properties and the need for working practices to avoid creating unnecessary noise and disturbance.	
(vi)	B800 road bridge demolition – FCBC advised that a planning meeting was to be held to discuss the traffic management and demolition after this NLG meeting. It was agreed that FCBC would present the predicted noise levels and mitigation proposals for discussion at the May NLG meeting.	FCBC

(vii)	FCBC advised that two maximum noise level threshold exceedances had been recorded at the Scotstoun monitor. These were both day time exceedances caused by the use of plant immediately adjacent to the monitorFCBC advised that the upcoming works at the Scotstoun House junction is immediately below the monitor and that it is possible that further exceedances may be recorded.

	viii)	FCBC advised that one complaint had been received during the period. This was from a resident on the south side or the river and occurred over two consecutive nights. Following investigation it was found that there was hammering on the first night and movement of scaffolding poles on the second. It was also noted that the usual foreman was off work and his replacement had not been as stringent with noise control as required. The team was re-briefed to highlight the importance of minimising noise. The NLG noted concern and recognised that improved controls had been in place since the incident.
