		FCBC updated the meeting on the requirement for this PCNV. It was agreed to run a trial period of at least one week starting on 14 th March and this will cover all operations listed in the Modification.	
		Monitoring results of the trial period will be discussed at the weekly tele-call before the PCNV is fully approved.	
	(iv)	Dundas Home Farm – Evening and Night Time working – Following discussions with the residents who would be affected by daytime working, residents requested that consideration be given to carrying out the works during evening and night time periods. FCBC sought agreement from the NLG to carry out the works during evening and night time periods, which was received subject to the necessary PCNV being in place. The works will take approximately one week with the noisier operations programmed for early evening where possible.	Note

	(v)	Additional monitors were setup at two locations during the works to transfer traffic onto the new Southbound lanes North of the Forth. Recorded levels were generally within the required thresholds except for the occasional passing of local traffic adjacent to the monitor locations.	
	(vi)	FCBC advised that they had been conducting further reviews of recorded noise levels to identify potential for improved noise management during the works. As part of this proactive noise management campaign, FCBC will re-brief teams if trends suggest noise level increases may be occurring. New noise campaigns will also be developed and rolled out throughout the site. Exceedances	Note
