Forth Crossing Bill	The Bill by which the Scottish Ministers seek powers from the Scottish Parliament to construct the scheme.	L
Policy Memorandum	Explains the policy objectives of the Forth Crossing Bill and other related matters.	L
Maps, Plans and Sections	A range of maps, plans and cross-sections showing the full extent of the scheme.	L
Book of Reference	A list of the land required for the scheme and the people who own, lease or occupy that land.	L
Explanatory Notes (and other accompanying documents*)	A summary of what each provision of the Bill does and other information necessary to explain the effect of the Bill.	L
*Financial Memorandum	Provides an estimate of the cost of the scheme and details of funding.	L
*Heritable Interests Statement	Details of how those whose property is affected by the Bill will be notified and details of how the Bill and accompanying documents will be distributed and advertised.	L
*Government's Statement on Legislative Competence	Statement giving the view of the Government on whether or not the provisions of the Bill are within the legislative competence of the Parliament.	L
*Presiding Officer's Statement on Legislative Competence	Statement giving the view of the Presiding Officer on whether or not the provisions of the Bill are within the legislative competence of the Parliament.	L
Environmental Statement	A report on the findings of the Environmental Impact Assessment.	L
Non Technical Summary of the Environmental Statement	A summary of the Environmental Statement.	L
Code of Construction Practice	Document setting out the measures to be put in place during construction to reduce impacts on the environment and communities.	L
Noise & Vibration Policy Statement	Statement of the approach the Scottish Ministers will take to assessing and mitigating noise impacts associated with the operation of the scheme.	L
Sustainability Appraisal & Carbon Management Report	A report setting out defined objectives and sustainable design measures with the aim of delivering a more sustainable scheme.	
Health Impact Assessment	A report presenting an appraisal of the possible health effects of the proposed scheme.	
Design Manual for Roads & Bridges Stage 3 Engineering Report	Engineering description and assessment of the scheme.	
Consultation & Engagement Report	A report documenting the consultation and engagement activities which were undertaken during the development of the scheme.
