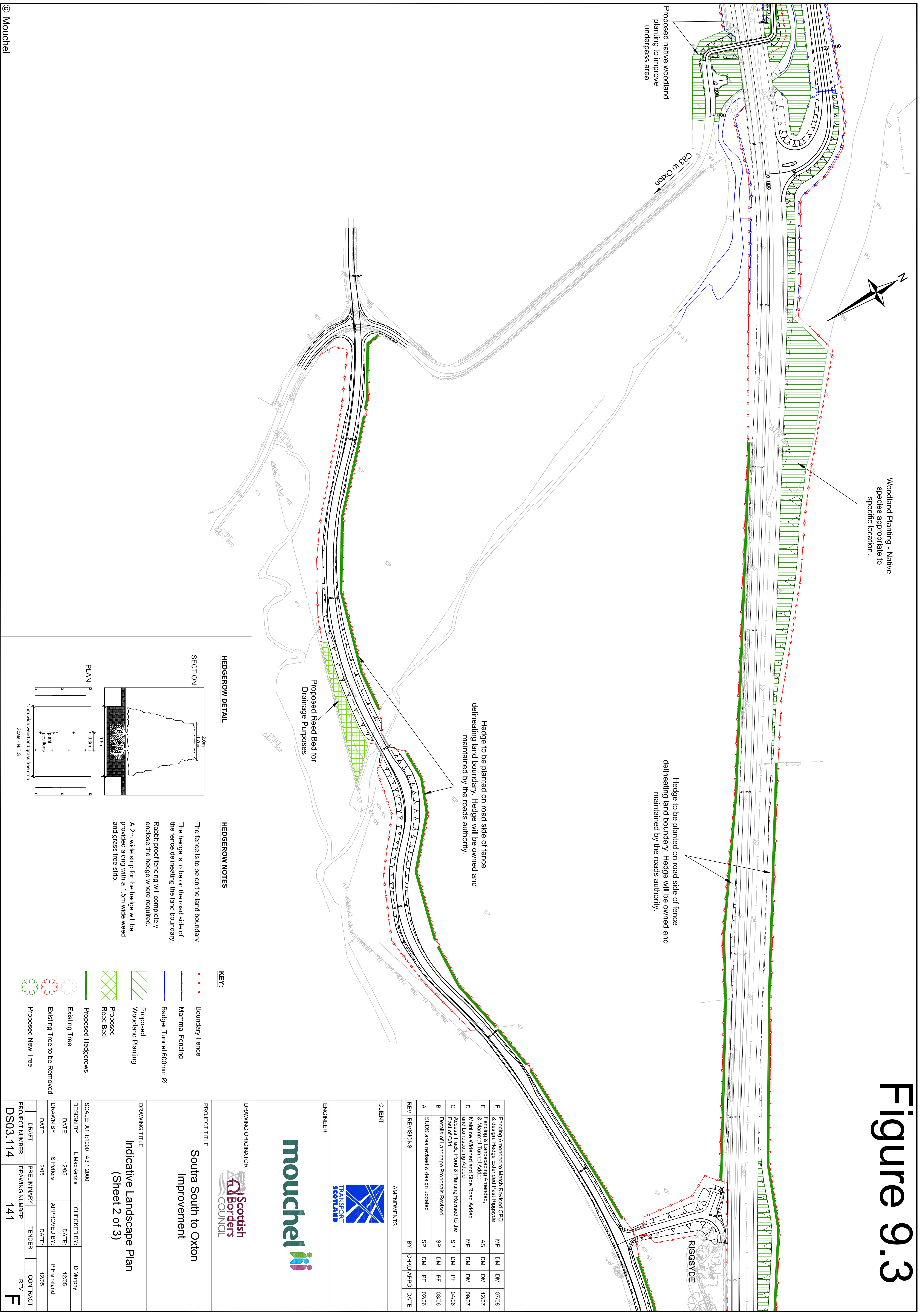

HEDGROW NOTES

The fence is to be on the land boundary. The hedge is to be on the road side of the fence delineating the land boundary. Rabbit proof fencing will completely enclose the hedge where required. A 2m wide strip for the hedge will be provided along with a 1.5m wide weed and grass free strip.
