4.2	Average Speed Camera System	
4.2.1	It was confirmed that the system is continuing to work well and proving effective in the controlling of speed.	
4.3	Wide Load Management	
4.3.1	FBOC reported that there has only been one instance where they have not had prior notification of an abnormal load crossing. This has been addressed with the company concerned.	
	EDT asked for confirmation of the process being adopted in practice. FBOC advised that the process being operated, and advertised on the website, is that the FRC is open for business for abnormal loads southbound but only with prior arrangements and a Police rolling road block in place. Police Scotland confirmed they have no issue with this. Northbound abnormal load movements remain the same system as previous.	
	It was confirmed that the Welldean layby is now effectively closed.	
	Police Scotland asked for confirmation of the provision for abnormal loads when the Queensferry Crossing is open. EDT advised that the Queensferry Crossing can be available for use by for abnormal loads in accordance with normal motorway regulations and abnormal load rules.

4.4.1	Forth Bridges Operating Company (FBOC)	
4.4.1.1	Contraflow planned for overnight Tuesday 14 February and also overnight Saturday 18 February both for southbound carriageway works. FBOC advised that no abnormal loads can be accommodated during the contraflow on 18 February due to the nature of the works being undertaken.	FBOC

5.1	Paint remedial works are to take place at Junction 1a as follows:	
	All nightshift	
	 Phase 1: Backspan and piers – Daytime works for approximately 10-12 days. Technical issues currently being discussed. 	
	 Phase 2: Above hard shoulder and nearside lanes (grinding and painting) – two lanes open West and one lane open East. Night-time repairs with a 40mph speed restriction. 	
	 Phase 3: Works on centre of spans. Two lanes open Eastbound and Westbound with a 40mph speed restriction. 	
	 Works on the overbridge hard shoulder will also be overnight matching the above lane closures. 	SRB
	These works are likely to be an 8 week programme, preferably commencing early March through to early May (SRB to confirm). EDT stated that if there was a risk of going beyond early May then some works may have to be postponed until later in the summer 2017.

	 Admiralty northbound diverge – Resurface slip road – Weekend closure 14th-16th April. This will need advertised. 	FCBC
	 Admiralty southbound merge and A90 – Reconstruct merge at A90 – Weekend slip and A90 lane closures – 21st–23rd and 28th-30th April. The Group requested the feasibility of undertaking this work during the Easter holiday period to be investigated.
