	(iv)	There was 1 exceedance during the period.	Note
		On the north side of the river, from metal banging during the night time period. No complaint was received regarding this exceedance.	
		Community Engagement	
	(v)	FCBC advised that a number of complaints had been received in the period:-  1. A resident on the North side of the river complained about early morning humming noise. This was investigated and found to be caused by the scour protection works at Pier N1. Although no exceedance was recorded it was agreed that the works would start at 08.00 rather than 06.00.	Note
		2. Three residents on the north side of the river complained individually over three separate evenings about night time noise. On investigation it was found to be caused by road marking removal on the north network. Temporary monitoring was offered but declined by the residents once the cause of the disturbance was explained.	
	(vi)	FCBC advised that breakers were required to remove material at the Area 1 storage area. Initially the works were programmed for Friday/ Saturday between 16.00 and 18.00. Following discussion it was agreed that the works should be carried out earlier in the day and not on a Saturday. Although this is to be undertaken during daytime hours it was felt that due to the proximity of houses a flyer was to be issued.  Post Meeting Note – Flyer was issued on Monday 6 <sup>th</sup> March for work	FCBC
		to be carried out between 09.00 and 16.00 on Friday 10 <sup>th</sup> March. It is expected that the works will take approx 3 hours within that period.
