DMRB Stage 3 Assessment – design development

The following figures show the updated design development work undertaken since the public exhibitions in March 2017. Some of the key updates to the design include:

- Optimisation of the main dual carriageway alignment with a view to reducing impacts
- Development of compact grade-separated junctions at Aviemore South, Granish and Black Mount to reduce the footprint and overall impact of the junction
- Development of proposals for the grade separated junction tieins to local roads – B9152 at Aviemore South and A95/B9152 at
- Development of proposals for the Slochd junction (U2400), Lynwilg Road (U3050) and private accesses
- Development of new and upgraded structures, Sustainable Drainage Systems (SuDS), Non-Motorised Users (NMUs) proposals and inclusion of lay-bys.

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
