	 Opening procession on the evening of 28 August with vintage buses and site cars followed by a lighting of the bridge between 2200 hours and 2300 hours. Evening of 29 August – Traffic switch onto Queensferry Crossing. Queensferry Crossing open to traffic under traffic management on 30 August and will close on evening of 31 August and switch back to Forth Road Bridge. 1 September – Preparation will start for events on 2 & 3 September. Official Opening will take place on 4 September. Locals & Schools event will take place and finish on evening of 5 September. The desirability of having a day after all of these to allow inspections of the bridge before re-opening on evening of 6 September was discussed and agreed. While various comments were raised during the site review, as recorded above. It was agreed that, subject to suitable completion of works on site and the RSA process, the Group confirmed that they saw no reason for the opening under TTMS not to proceed.	EDT
