**ROADS TRAFFIC**

**The A9 Trunk Road (Tomatin to Moy) (Prohibition of Specified Turns) Order 201[ ]**

*Made* - - - - 201[ ]

*Coming into force* - - 201[ ]

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 1(1)(a), 2(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) and all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section 1(1) of that Act, they consider it expedient to make this Order for avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising.

The Scottish Ministers have complied with Parts II and III of the Secretary of State's Traffic Orders (Procedure) (Scotland) Regulations 1987(b).

**Citation and commencement**

1. This Order may be cited as the A9 Trunk Road (Tomatin to Moy) (Prohibition of Specified Turns) Order 201[ ] and comes into force on [ ].

**Prohibition of specified turns**

2. No person may use, or cause or permit the use of, any vehicle on the length of road specified in Part 1 of the schedule of this Order so as to make any turn specified in Part 2 of the schedule.

The functions of the Secretary of State were transferred to the Scottish Ministers by section 53 of the Scotland Act 1998 (c.46).

### **Exemption for emergency vehicles**

**3.** No prohibition imposed by this Order applies to any vehicle while being used in an emergency for fire brigade, ambulance, police or coastguard purposes.

## SCHEDULE

Article 2

### PART 1

That length of the existing M9/A9 Edinburgh - Stirling - Thurso Trunk Road, from a point 11 metres or thereby south-east of its junction with the U2856 Slochd to Findhorn Bridge Road, north-westwards to a point 10 metres or thereby north-west of that junction, a distance of 21 metres or thereby.

### PART 2

1. All U-turns on that length of the M9/A9 Edinburgh - Stirling - Thurso Trunk Road.
2. All right turns from the M9/A9 Edinburgh - Stirling - Thurso Trunk Road to the U2856 Slochd to Findhorn Bridge Road.
3. All right turns to the M9/A9 Edinburgh - Stirling - Thurso Trunk Road from the U2856 Slochd to Findhorn Bridge Road.
