PART 1

PUBLIC RIGHT OF WAY TO BE EXTINGUISHED

- 1. A length of the existing public right of way, not being a vehicular right of way, along an unnamed track, leading from General Wade's Military Road, in a generally northerly direction, to the verge of the existing M9/A9 Edinburgh Stirling Thurso Trunk Road, Inverness-shire.
- 2. A length of the existing public right of way, not being a vehicular right of way, along part of General Wade's Military Road and the connecting unnamed path, in a generally southwesterly direction, leading to the verge of the existing M9/A9 Edinburgh Stirling Thurso Trunk Road, Inverness-shire.
- 3. A length of the existing public right of way, not being a vehicular right of way, which crosses beneath the existing M9/A9 Edinburgh Stirling Thurso Trunk Road in a generally south-easterly then north-easterly direction, between two parts of General Wade's Military Road, Inverness-shire.

PART 2

ALTERNATIVE RIGHT OF WAY TO BE PROVIDED

- 1. A public right of way, not being a vehicular right of way, leading from General Wade's Military Road at the point where the existing right of way is to be extinguished, in a generally north-easterly direction, to another part of General Wade's Military Road at the point where the existing right of way is to be extinguished, parallel to the M9/A9 Edinburgh Stirling Thurso Trunk Road, Inverness-shire.
- 2. A public right of way, not being a vehicular right of way, crossing beneath the M9/A9 Edinburgh Stirling Thurso Trunk Road, leading from General Wade's Military Road at the point where the existing right of way is to be extinguished, in a generally north-easterly then south-easterly direction to another part of General Wade's Military Road at the point where the existing right of way is to be extinguished, Inverness-shire.
