- 1. The A737/A738 Trunk Road (Improvements At Beith) (Trunking And Detrunking) Order 2020 under section 5(2) and (6) of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 ("the Act");
- 2. The A737/A738 Trunk Road (Improvements At Beith) (Side Roads) Order 2020 under sections 12(1) and (5) and 70(1) of the Act; and
- 3. The A737/A738 Trunk Road (Improvements At Beith) (Redetermination Of Means Of Exercise Of Public Right Of Passage) Order 2020 under sections 2(1) and 152(2) of the Act.

The Orders as made become operative on 9 December 2020, being the date on which this notice is first published. In accordance with the Coronavirus (Scotland) Act 2020, Schedule 6, Part 3, para 9, the Orders and Plans will not be available for inspection at public display locations.

Any person aggrieved by either of these Orders who wishes to question their validity or any of the provisions therein on the grounds that they are not within the powers of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 or that any requirement of the Act or any regulations made under the Act have not been complied with in relation to the Orders may, within 6 weeks of 9 December 2020, make application to the Court of Session for the suspension of the operation of, or the quashing of, the Orders or any provision contained therein.
